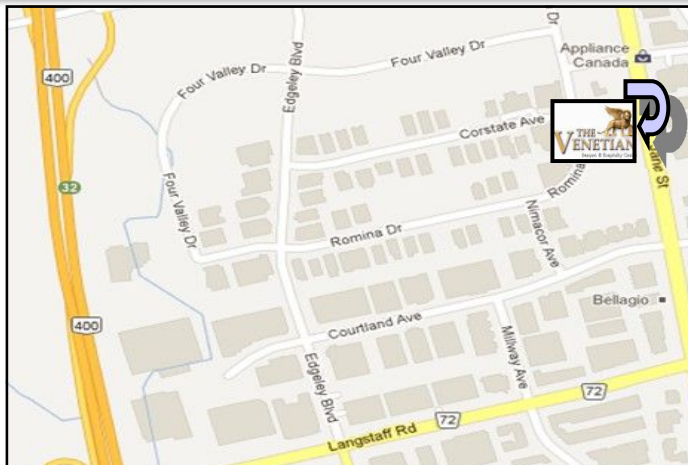

Formulators, researchers and marketers who want to learn more about natural products used in natural personal care products with focus on botanicals.

Course Overview

What are natural products? Why do we want to formulate with them? The Natural & Organic Market – USDA and NGO certifying bodies. Rationales for ingredient acceptability and restriction.
